

PASTOR / CHURCH PLANTER TRAINING

One of the greatest challenges our churches face is the lack of quality options for formal theological training. They once had a seminary but it was shut down over 20 years ago due to lack of resources. We have decided to partner with "Bible Training Centre for Pastors" to set up a program for providing on the job ministry and theological training for pastors and church planters. This will all be done through the ministry of the local churches and will be led and taught by experienced and qualified Dominican pastors. Dan will be participating in online training for this program on October 20-21. Once he completes the certification program, he can begin certifying and training Dominican pastors to teach these courses. BTCP's materials are available in 34 languages and are being used in over 100 countries to train local pastors and church leaders. This will be a practical resource they can continue to use to train their own pastors, church planters, and lay leaders for generations to come.
